installation costs and reduces what you owe in federal income taxes for the year.

How much do solar panels cost in Alabama?

The average-sized 6-kilowatt solar panel system in Alabama costs \$18,000 before incentives. Once you consider the federal solar tax credit, the cost of solar panels in Alabama drops to \$12,600. Federal tax credit:  $$18,000 \times 30\% = $5,400$
