Where can I buy solar panels?

A DOE-funded study at the Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory found that solar panels are viewed as upgrades, just like a renovated kitchen or a



finished basement, and home buyers across the country have been willing to pay a premium of about \$15,000 for a home with an average-sized solar array.
