Technically, yes—you're allowed to install solar panels on your own property. However, it must still comply with building regulations, electrical safety standards, and local planning rules. 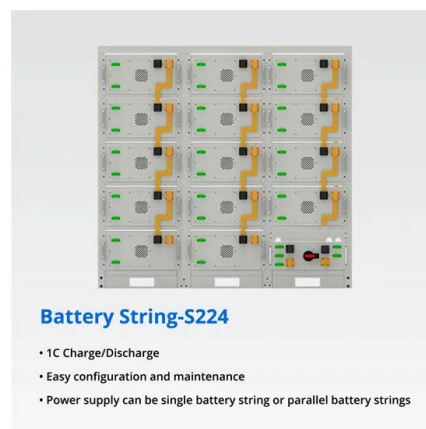

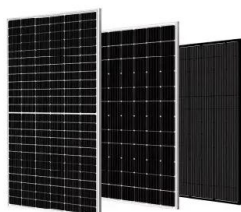
