These twenty-four solar terms each suggest the position of the sun every time it travels 15 degrees on the ecliptic longitude. A cycle is that earth



revolves around the sun for one time.

What are the two major solar terms?

As early as the Spring and Autumn Period (770-476 BC), ancient Chinese ancestors established two major solar terms: Summer Solstice and Winter Solstice, meaning "Sun North Most" and "Sun South Most," respectively.
