Overview

Are solar power systems worth the investment?

Thanks to the lower-than-ever cost of solar panels and various solar incentives, solar panels are a cost-effective investment for the majority of homeowners that will provide an excellent return on investment.

How much do solar power systems cost?

The average cost to install solar panels in the United States is about \$12,000 after federal tax incentives. On the low end, you can install a smaller system for around \$5,000, while a high-priced Tier 1 solar panel system can cost \$40,000 or more. There are additional costs that go into an installation project beyond the price of panels.

What are the average solar panel costs per kWh?

Solar panels cost \$1.77 to \$2.20 per watt and a 6 kW solar panel installation for the average home costs from \$10,626 to \$13,230 after the 30% federal solar tax credit. Solar energy costs \$0.08 to \$0.10 per kWh to produce on average, depending on your location.

How much do solar panels cost to install?

The average cost to install solar panels is from \$10,626 to \$26,460 (after tax credit) for a 6kW to 12kW system to power an entire house. The average solar panel payback period is 7 to 12 years, and solar energy saves \$600 to \$2,000 per year on electricity costs.
