The national average cost for removing 14 to 16 solar panels for a 1,500 sq.ft. roof is between \$2,800 and \$4,800. Most people pay around \$3,800 to remove, disconnect, and reinstall 15 panels after the roof is replaced. At the low end of the spectrum, however, you can opt only to have 15 solar.

What factors affect the cost of a solar panel removal service?

The age of your system, the size, and types of solar panels, the kind of mounting, your inverter, number of panels, and your roof's height will affect the cost and labor involved in the project. A licensed solar company should be



responsible for the solar panel removal service .

How much does a solar roof repair cost?

Since solar panels outlast some roof materials, you'll likely need to remove and reinstall the panels at some point during their lifespan to access the roof structure for repair or replacement. Roof repair costs \$150 to \$1,000 to fix minor problems, or up to \$6,000+ to repair more extensive damage.
