1. Green Retrofit Solar Panel Grants Note: Funds must be used within 2 years of receiving them. 2. High Energy Cost Grants Extra tip: You must prove your area's average energy cost exceeds 275% of the national average. 3. Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP) 4. Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP).

What is the \$7 billion solar for all program?

Under the \$7 billion Solar for All program, the 60 grant recipients will create new or expand existing low-income solar programs, which will enable over 900,000 households in low-income and disadvantaged communities to benefit from distributed solar energy.

Luckily, the U.S. government has your back. Whether you're a low-income homeowner or a rural resident, there are plenty of grants and funding options in 2025 to make solar energy accessible, affordable, and efficient.

Who will receive a \$7 billion solar grant?

Washington – Today, April 22, as the Biden-Harris Administration celebrates Earth Day, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency announced 60 selectees that will receive \$7 billion in grant awards through the Solar for All grant competition to deliver residential solar projects to over 900,000 households nationwide.

How will EPA's 60 solar for all program help low-income households?

EPA estimates that the 60 Solar for All recipients will enable over 900,000 households in low-income and disadvantaged communities to deploy and benefit from distributed solar energy. This \$7 billion investment will generate over \$350 million in annual savings on electric bills for overburdened



Does Washington have a solar program?

Washington's proposal includes a program focused on single-family homeowners, a program that helps multifamily affordable housing properties access other state and federal solar incentives, and a program focused on Tribal solar deployment that will be co-designed with Tribal governments.


