The biggest incentive in 2025 comes from electricity retailers offering competitive rates for excess solar energy you send back to the grid.

Is there a government subsidy for solar hot water systems?

Launched back in 2007, there was a Government subsidy for solar hot water systems, but this (solar thermal) is an entirely different technology from solar power (photovoltaics). The incentive granted consumers \$500 towards a solar hot water system, which saw a short boom in the uptake of solar water heaters.

Are government-funded solar rebates a viable option for homeowners in 2025?

While previous proposals for government-funded solar rebates haven't come to fruition, the landscape is still supportive in other ways. The combination of generous buy-back schemes, attractive financing, and community programs keeps solar energy a strong option for homeowners in 2025.



How can the government help with solar energy installation?

The government offers various grants and subsidies to assist with the installation costs of solar systems. For example, the EECA's Solar Water Heating Grant provides financial support for the installation of solar water heating systems, making it easier for Kiwis to switch to renewable energy sources.

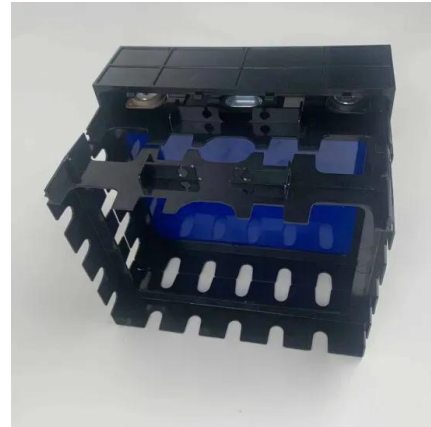

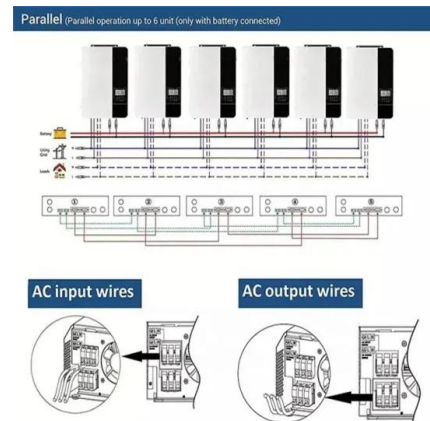
