

Government subsidy for containerized solar power plant in Belgium





Overview

The Flemish government started the subsidy scheme Green Heat in 2020, with calls for applications twice a year. The long title of the funding programme is “Call groene warmte restwarmte en energie-efficiënte stadsverwarming”. Will a new energy subsidy make Brussels more green?

Proponents hope that an increased subsidy will incentivise more Brussels residents to greenify their energy. Another incentive is the exploding energy prices affecting Europe, which Belgium is hoping to cushion through legislation.


