

Government subsidy for mobile solar station in Croatia





Overview

The Croatian Ministry of Environmental Protection and Green Transition and the Environmental Protection and Energy Efficiency Fund (FZOEU) have unveiled plans to allocate EUR 652 million in subsidies in 2025. How much money does Croatia need to install solar power in 2022?

The Croatian government has allocated €60 million (\$65.6 million) in subsidies for businesses to install 80 MW of renewables and 20 MWh of batteries. Croatia may only install 2.5 MW of PV in 2022.

How many MW of PV will Croatia install in 2022?

Croatia may only install 2.5 MW of PV in 2022. The Croatian government is providing €60 million for companies in the processing industry and heating sector to install front-of-the-meter and behind-the-meter PV arrays, biomass projects, biogas-fired power plants, and battery storage installations.

What can we expect from EU funding in Croatia?

The EU funding and the Croatian government initiatives will likely result in an increased demand for innovative, reliable, and cost-effective renewable energy solutions in Croatia. We can expect more solar and geothermal power plants, and more production facilities installed by consumers for their own consumption and trade.

What are the government's plans for the solar industry?

The government has committed to integrate these suggestions into the Law on Renewables and Highly Efficient Cogeneration and the Law on Electricity Market. The legislation changes should be adopted by the end of 2021. Additionally, the government is considering favorable loans to households for installing solar panels.
