In line with the EU regulations on state subsidies, the European Commission approved the Croatian subsidy programme for the production of electric power from renewable energy sources in the amount of 783 million EUR. The measure will help Croatia to attain its goals related to energy from renewable.

The Ministry of Economy has officially announced the "State Support Program for Facilities for Storing Self-Produced Electricity for the Purpose of Deferred Energy Delivery to the Grid". This program represents a significant opportunity for companies looking to invest in modern energy storage.

Croatia's Ministry of Environmental Protection and Green Transition has announced plans to allocate €651.8 million in grants next year. Of this amount, €526.8 million will come from the European Union's 2021-2027 competition and cohesion program, the EU's national recovery and resilience plan, and.

In 2025, Croatia is expected to launch several targeted funding calls relevant to zero-emission mobility: Zero-emission vehicle purchase for fleets: In Q4 2025, a public call will support the purchase of vehicles with zero tailpipe emissions (including BEVs) by taxi services and delivery companies.



Croatia has earmarked EUR 25 million for households at risk of energy poverty. They will use the funds for the energy renovation. The subsidies for households at risk of energy poverty are part of a EUR 652 million package for 2025 launched by the Ministry of Environmental Protection and Green.

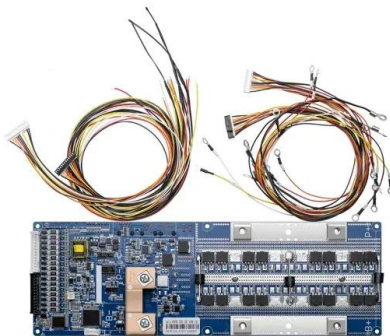
