Government subsidy for turnkey containerized solar in Romania





Overview

The Romanian Ministry of Energy has signed 29 more grants to public entities for investments in solar power plants for self-consumption, bringing the total number of projects under the program to 1,046. The latest round of grants is worth EUR 11.3 million, putting the total sum approved so far at.

The €310 million (\$351 million) funding package includes over €268 million ringfenced for solar installations for self-consumption. The deadline for companies to submit applications is August 21. Romania's Ministry of Energy has launched its second funding call to support new renewable energy.

Romania is making significant strides in its commitment to sustainable energy by offering subsidies to local authorities to bolster the installation of solar power systems. This forward-thinking initiative is designed to empower municipalities to receive funding for projects that generate.

On 31 March 2022, the Romanian Ministry of Energy launched a call for projects under a new state aid scheme for supporting the development of new wind and solar power plants, with or without integrated power storage capacities (the "Support Scheme"). This is the first support scheme launched for.



The Romanian government has launched a EUR-310.7-million (USD 353.5m) funding initiative to support the deployment of new renewable energy installations for self-consumption, largely solar plants. The scheme, financed by the Modernization Fund, is the second one targeting self-consumption projects.




