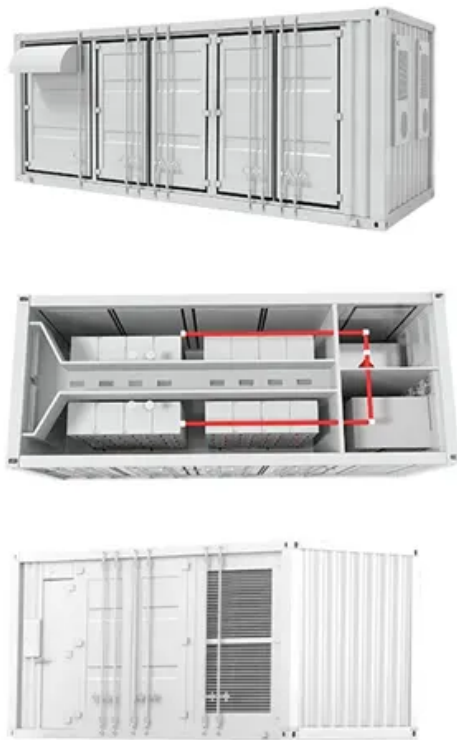

You might encounter one of four solar home scenarios when you're shopping for a house: fully-owned solar panels, leased solar panels, solar panels purchased with a solar loan, and PACE (Property Assessed Clean Energy) financed solar panels.

Does buying a house with solar panels affect a mortgage?

Buying a house with solar panels can affect the way you get a mortgage. In particular, matters like owning or leasing the panels and how the panels were financed might affect your mortgage. If the seller of your soon-to-be home



outright owns the solar panels, that's ideal; the panels will likely only affect the home's price.

Should you buy a home with a third-party Solar System?

When buying a house with solar panels, homebuyers should ask whether the solar system is owned outright by the seller or whether they would have to take over a lease' (SEIA vice president of markets and research, Justin Baca).
