How do I calculate my solar tax credit?

Calculating the amount of your federal solar tax credit is very simple. Take the total cost your system and multiply it by 0.30. For example, if you spent \$25,000 all-in on going solar (parts, labor, permits, etc), then your tax credit would be worth \$7,500. \$25,000 (gross cost) x 0.30 (30% tax credit) = \$7,500 Residential Clean Energy Credit.

Are solar panels tax deductible?

No! If you install a solar panel system on a home you own, you can claim the whole credit and sell at any point afterward. If you are buying a house with solar panels—even if the previous owner just installed them—you're not eligible for any portion of the tax credit.

When can I claim a solar tax credit?

You can claim the federal solar tax credit this year as long as you have a tax liability and installed your system before January 1, 2026. After this year, homeowners will no longer qualify for the ITC. What are the steps for claiming solar tax credit for tax year 2024 and 2025?
