How do I install solar panels?

Ground-mounted panels can be installed anywhere with good sun exposure and enough open space. A minimum of 350 square feet is usually required. Installing solar panels requires the following steps: Plan the solar energy system based on the home's size, location and energy needs. Measure, cut and assemble the support structure for the solar array.

Is a DIY solar panel installation a good idea?

How do you install solar panels on a flat roof?

For Sloped Roofs - a railed system is commonly used. This consists of attaching a set of rails to the roof to hold the solar modules. Flashings, screws and bolts are used to attach these rails by drilling the roof and using sealant to prevent water leakage. For Flat Roofs - Installers use either ballasts or concrete blocks to rack the solar panels.

Should you install solar panels yourself?

You can install solar panels yourself, but doing it alone involves risks—especially when working against a deadline. Incentives can drastically lower your overall cost, but solar is still a big investment. To save money, it's no surprise that many homeowners consider a DIY approach.


