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LUSAKA, April 1, 2025 – Access to electricity in Zambia has risen from 30% in 2017 to currently nearly 50%. Whilst half of the population is connected, the remaining half will require new energy solutions. Zambia currently relies on hydropower for 80% its electricity generation, but recent droughts.

Will Zambia invest in off-grid solar energy?

In collaboration with the World Bank, the Common Market for Eastern and Southern Africa (COMESA), the Africa Minigrid Development Association (AMDA), and other partners, the Government of Zambia is redoubling its efforts to invest in off-grid solar energy throughout the country to connect all Zambians.

Why does Zambia have a low electricity supply?

Zambia has 2,800MW of installed electricity generation capacity (85 per cent is hydro) but erratic rains, declining water levels in the Kariba Dam and an increasing population have resulted in a severe supply deficit. The country's electricity demand has been rising by more than 6 per cent (or 150-200MW) per year for the past decade.⁶

Should e-waste standards be adopted in Zambia?

This should stimulate business growth in the SAS sector by lowering the cost



of importing goods into the country. The Zambian Bureau of Standards (ZABS) and Zambia Information and Communications Technology Authority (ZICTA) are leading the adoption of e-waste standards. There are 11 proposed standards, four of which have been adopted.
