

Is the Solar System a flat structure?

The planes of the orbits of the planets are closely aligned with one another (recall that the orbits of the planets lay close to the ecliptic), meaning that it is not unreasonable to think of the solar system as a flat structure. Radioactive dating of rocks and meteorites suggest that the solar system formed approximately 4.6 billion years ago.
