SolarAPP+ is a third-party software program that can be used to verify code compliance for residential photovoltaic (PV) projects. The City of Phoenix Planning & Development Department (PDD) will accept SolarAPP+ approved designs for application and permitting of residential photovoltaic projects.

Do I need a permit to install a solar PV system?

In most instances you won't need a permit to install a solar PV system. Some local governments may require a permit in certain circumstances, for example if you are in a heritage overlay area or your property is a listed heritage building.

How do I get a permit for a ground-mounted solar system?

For a ground-mounted PV system, you can submit the permit application online. The Arizona Corporation Commission provides this information on their Arizona Goes Solar website for additional details on solar energy and incentives.

Do I need a permit to install a solar roof?

State laws ensure local governments cannot unreasonably hinder solar adoption, but individual jurisdictions retain authority over permitting processes, inspection requirements, and zoning restrictions. Local permitting typically requires an electrical permit and, in some cases, a structural permit if roof modifications are involved.

Do I need a zoning permit for solar panels?

Zoning permits may still be required where building permit exemptions exist. Building exemptions do not apply to floodplain areas. Before occupying a new residence or business an occupancy permit is required. PV Solar Panel permits are priced as follows: \$7.00 per panel and a flat fee of \$75.00.

Do I need a planning permit to build a solar energy facility?

Apart from a planning permit for the construction of a solar energy facility, other approvals and licences may be required under state and federal



legislation to remove native vegetation or wildlife, to manage impacts on cultural heritage and matters of national environmental significance and to facilitate road access and utility connections.
