What is the Solar for all program?

The Solar for All program and other parts of the Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund aim to expand access to solar power. The Capital Good Fund will use the \$156 million award from Solar for All for its Georgia BRIGHT solar leasing program, which the group estimated will serve about 21,000 low-income households over five years.

Who received solar for all grants in 2024?

Solar for All awarded grants in August 2024 to 49 state-level agencies, six tribes and five multi-state award recipients, according to the EPA. They include state agencies like the Alaska Energy Authority, which was granted a \$62 million award to offer access to renewable energy in both urban and rural areas.

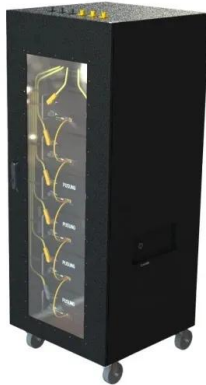
What is solar for all?

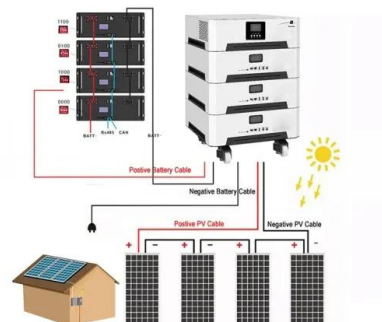

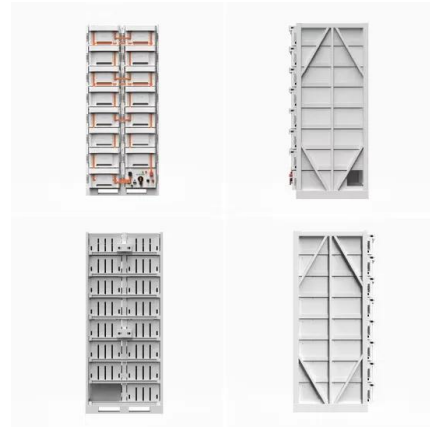
