Under the \$7 billion Solar for All program, the 60 grant recipients will create new or expand existing low-income solar programs, which will enable over 900,000 households in low-income and disadvantaged communities to benefit from distributed solar energy.

What is a solar for all grant?

Grantees must use all Solar for All program funds to enable communities that fall within the scope of EPA's definition of low-income and disadvantaged communities to deploy and benefit from residential distributed solar.

Who is eligible for a solar grant?

This competition will award up to 60 grants to states, territories, Tribal governments, municipalities, and eligible nonprofit recipients to expand the number of low-income and disadvantaged communities primed for distributed solar investment—enabling millions of low-income households to access affordable, resilient, and clean solar energy.

Are financial products eligible under solar for all?

Yes, providing financial products to communities and businesses to enable low-income and disadvantaged communities to deploy and benefit from distributed residential solar is an eligible activity under Solar for All. These financial products would be classified as project-deployment technical assistance for the purposes of this program.

Can solar for all grant funds be used for financial assistance?

No, Solar for All grant funds must be used for financial assistance and technical assistance to enable low-income and disadvantaged communities to



deploy and benefit from rooftop residential solar and residential-serving community solar as defined in Section I.D: Competition Terminology of the Notice of Funding Opportunity.


