The Solar for All program is a \$7 billion competitive grant program through the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Greenhouse Gas Fund, authorized by the Inflation Reduction Act. It is designed to deploy residential and community solar photovoltaic (PV) projects benefiting.

AHFC's efforts will be on a statewide residential program for low to moderate income households that provides subsidized solar installations for utility grid-connected households where net metering applies. Number of households to benefit will likely be 800-1,500.

These initiatives are intended to help lower energy costs for residents, especially in remote and rural communities where prices are often much higher. Through partnerships with state and federal agencies, these investments can improve quality of life, create jobs, stimulate economic growth, and.

One of the fund's three programs, a \$7 billion Solar For All program, was created to deploy distributed solar energy projects - including residential rooftop solar, residential-serving community and shared solar, and storage



solutions – to 60 grant recipients, ranging across all 50 states, plus.

AHFC provides statewide financing for multi-family complexes and single-family homes with loan options for low- to moderate-income borrowers, veterans, teachers, nurses, public safety officers and those living in rural areas. AHFC provides energy efficiency programs, low-income rental assistance. What is Alaska's solar for all grant?

Under the State of Alaska's Solar for All grant, AEA partnered with the Alaska Housing Finance Corporation to expand access to solar energy across the state.

Does Alaska have a solar program?

In spring 2024, the EPA announced the conditional award of two \$62.45 million Solar for All grants for Alaska: a state government grant to the Alaska Energy Authority (AEA) and a tribal grant to Tanana Chiefs Conference (TCC).

Is Alaska suitable for solar power?


Alaska's remote settlements make it ideal for self-sustaining renewables like small-scale solar. With rising fuel costs, Alaska is suitable for solar power. The legislature should adopt aggressive measures to promote solar use by its residents.

What happened to the Solar for all program?

The Alaska Energy Authority has received formal notice from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency stating that the Solar for All program has been terminated nationwide. In 2024, AEA was successful in securing a grant award of \$62.5 million under this competitive program.
