

MADISON — Gov. Tony Evers announced today, as the state and country celebrate Earth Week, that Wisconsin is receiving a grant of \$62.4 million from the Biden-Harris Administration to help fund solar systems for low- and moderate-income households across Wisconsin. Wisconsin is among 60 states.

Through this program, 60 agencies will deploy federal funding for states, territories, Tribal governments, municipalities, and non-profits to deploy more solar programs. These solar programs will assist disadvantaged and low-income communities through direct funding for solar and green job.


