## Overview

---

How do I apply for solar for all?

The lead applicant of coalition applications must have submitted a Notice of Intent (NOI) by the listed deadline and according to the instructions in Section I.F: Required Notice of Intent and described in Section III.C Threshold Eligibility of the Notice of Funding Opportunity to be eligible for Solar for All.

Who is eligible for solar for all?

States, territories, Tribal governments, municipalities, and eligible nonprofit recipients are eligible to apply for Solar for All. These categories include:  
States & Territories: All 50 states, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, Guam, American Samoa, and the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands.

What is a solar for all program?

A Solar for All program has a scope of work to provide financial assistance to many projects while providing multifaceted technical assistance sub-programs to many energy market stakeholders. A program has a scope of work that has catalytic impacts on the distributed residential solar market beyond the projects the program directly funds.

What is solar for all?

Solar for All is focused on funding programs that provide financial assistance and technical assistance to enable low-income and disadvantaged communities to deploy and benefit from residential solar. Are there any similar federal programs that support non-residential solar projects?

What is the \$7 billion solar for all program?

Under the \$7 billion Solar for All program, the 60 grant recipients will create



new or expand existing low-income solar programs, which will enable over 900,000 households in low-income and disadvantaged communities to benefit from distributed solar energy.


#### What is a solar for all grant?

Grantees must use all Solar for All program funds to enable communities that fall within the scope of EPA's definition of low-income and disadvantaged communities to deploy and benefit from residential distributed solar.
