Under the \$7 billion Solar for All program, the 60 grant recipients will create new or expand existing low-income solar programs, which will enable over 900,000 households in low-income and disadvantaged communities to benefit from distributed solar energy.

What are the best solar companies in Texas?

According to Solar Tribune's 2021 list, the best solar companies in Texas in terms of cost per watt are: NRG Clean Power: \$3.06 per watt, Tesla: \$2.64 per watt, Vivint: \$3.76 per watt, Sweetwater Energy Services: \$2.43 per watt, Sunrun: \$3.83 per watt, SunPower: \$4.23 per watt, Solartime USA: \$2.75 per watt".

Are solar panels a good choice for Texas?

Solar panels are a good choice in Texas due to its high solar irradiation. To maximize savings on above-average utility bills and withstand strong winds, panels with a high efficiency rating and high maximum wind load are recommended.

Which companies have gone solar in Texas?

Several companies have gone solar in Texas. Anheuser Busch, Davita, and Target have all installed solar projects in the state. Anheuser Busch's 290 MW RE Maplewood project in McCamey is one of the largest corporate solar projects in Texas. Additionally, Prospero in Andrews, developed by Longroad Energy and came online in 2021, produces enough electricity to power 86,620 homes.


