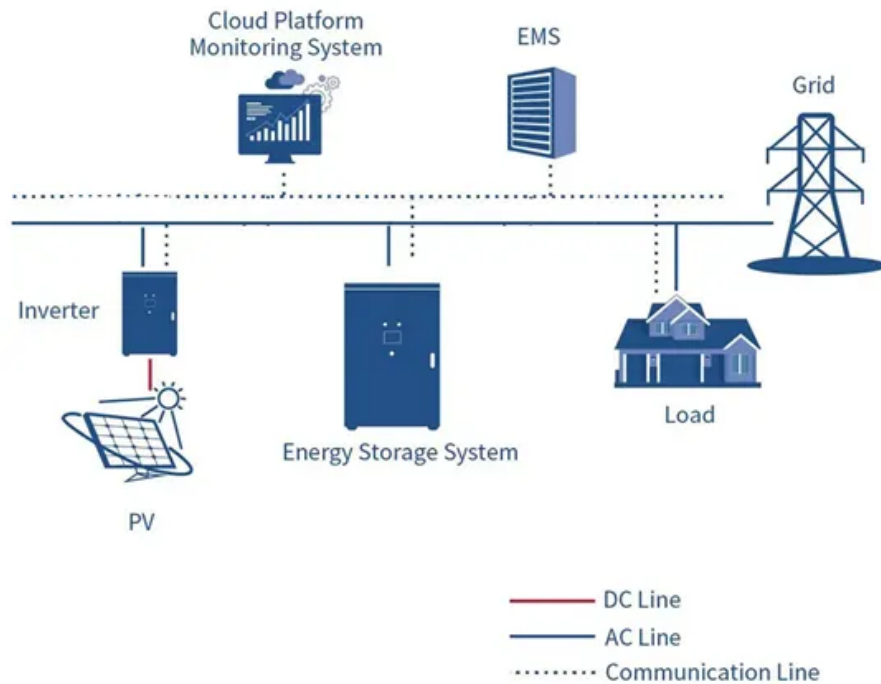


Solar oven with pizza box
