What is a rooftop solar subsidy scheme in India?

The rooftop solar subsidy scheme in India goes by the name, PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana. Under this scheme, homeowners can claim a subsidy between Rs. 30,000 and Rs. 78,000, depending upon the size of the on-grid rooftop solar system being installed. And are there any conditions for claiming this solar panel subsidy in India?

Absolutely!.

Will government give subsidies for rooftop solar panels in 2024-25?

The Budget 2024-25 emphasised this yojana and provided that the government will give subsidies for the installment of solar panels to 1 crore households. Under this scheme, subsidies are provided for installing rooftop solar panels for residential houses to supply power to households.

How will a government subsidy affect solar panels?

The Central Government will provide substantive subsidies directly to people's



bank accounts and heavily concessional bank loans to ensure that there is no cost burden on the people. The government subsidy will cover up to 40% of the cost of installation of the solar panels.

How do solar subsidies work?

The primary driver of these subsidies is the MNRE, which oversees the Grid-Connected Rooftop Solar Programme (Phase II). Through this scheme, subsidies are disbursed via state DISCOMs (Distribution Companies). Many state governments also have their own schemes, offering extra perks for the adoption of solar energy.
