

Do solar panels pay off in Tennessee?

Based on feedback from dozens of solar customers in Tennessee, solar panel investments tend to pay off over time. Assuming an upfront purchase, it takes about 12.5 years to break even (when your savings with solar panels make up for the cost). This is lower than the average price of residential solar power systems across



the United States, which is currently \$3.03 per watt. The size of a solar panel system also plays a role in how much the installation will cost. Larger solar installations typically have a lower cost per watt because the panels can be purchased at a 'bulk price.'
