

The U.S. government offers a solar tax credit that can help you recoup up to 30% of the cost of installing a solar power system. The residential clean energy credit also covers other types of renewable energy projects undertaken by homeowners, subject to certain guidelines. To claim the solar tax credit, you'll have to fill out IRS Form 5695.

How much is the residential solar energy credit worth?

The residential solar energy credit is worth 30% of the installed system costs through 2025. What is the Residential Clean Energy Credit?

In an effort to encourage Americans to use solar power, the US government offers tax credits for solar systems.

How do I qualify for a solar panel tax credit?

In order to qualify for the solar panel tax credit, you must own your home (not lease or rent) and you must pay enough taxes to the federal government (tax liability) that the Residential Clean Energy Credit can offset your tax payment.

Are solar panels a tax credit for 2025?

A July 2025 report published by the Department of Energy predicts 100 times more power outages by 2030 compared to today. Similar to solar panels, batteries must be installed by January 1, 2026 to claim the 30% federal tax credit.

Can I claim a solar tax credit on a home improvement?

Form 5695 is also used to claim tax credits of up to \$3,200 for other home improvements, such as new windows and insulation, through the energy efficient home credit. Does the solar tax credit work with other incentives?


