

Solar panels programs for homes





Overview

Currently, there are no federal or state government programs that provide free solar panels to low-income solar customers, but there are programs in place to greatly reduce the upfront cost. What grants are available for solar panels?

1. Green Retrofit Solar Panel Grants Note: Funds must be used within 2 years of receiving them. 2. High Energy Cost Grants Extra tip: You must prove your area's average energy cost exceeds 275% of the national average. 3. Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP) 4. Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP).

Are there any low-income solar programs available?

Yes, there are a number of low-income solar programs to help qualifying homeowners get home solar panels. These programs are run at the state, non-profit, and utility levels. Although there are no federally-run programs, the Biden-Harris Administration announced \$7 billion in Solar for All funding to create and expand low-income solar access.

Which federal programs cover solar installation costs?

Additional federal programs include the Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP) and the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP), which can help cover solar installation costs for eligible households.

Are solar panels free?

While solar programs for low-income households offer significant savings, they're typically not completely free. However, many programs cover up to 100% of installation costs through grants, tax incentives, and subsidies, making solar power highly affordable. Do I need to own my home to qualify?

Who owns the solar panels in this program?



Under the program, homeowners do not own the solar panels. Instead, they are leasing them at no cost and receive 100% of the clean energy produced by the system. The goal is to have homeowners and renters see at least 50% savings on their electricity bill over 15 years.

What is the \$7 billion solar for all program?

Under the \$7 billion Solar for All program, the 60 grant recipients will create new or expand existing low-income solar programs, which will enable over 900,000 households in low-income and disadvantaged communities to benefit from distributed solar energy.
