Overview

The Solar for All program, created by the U.S. EPA (Environmental Protection Agency) in 2024 and funded by the Inflation Reduction Act of 2022, was launched with a total funding pool of \$7 billion to significantly expand solar energy access, reduce greenhouse gas.

The Environmental Protection Agency announced Thursday it is terminating its \$7 billion Solar for All program that was designed to bring renewable and affordable energy to low-income communities. Sources confirmed to CBS News earlier this week that the agency planned to scrap the program. Solar for.

Solar for All is a \$7 billion competitive grants program administered by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. In April 2024, EPA awarded 60 grants to states, territories, Tribal governments, municipalities, and nonprofits to expand the number of low-income and disadvantaged communities primed.

The EPA's termination of the \$7 billion Solar for All program halts solar power access for nearly one million low-income households, including \$156 million in Michigan projects. The EPA has shut down the \$7 billion Solar for All program, ceasing \$156 million in Michigan projects aimed at supplying.

Under the \$7 billion Solar for All program, the 60 grant recipients will create new or expand existing low-income solar programs, which will enable over 900,000 households in low-income and disadvantaged communities to benefit from distributed solar energy.

What is solar for all?

"Solar for All is an investment in energy infrastructure that's going to serve that residential customer that's going to keep energy rates in America more affordable and more fair," she said. Solar for All awarded grants in August 2024 to 49 state-level agencies, six tribes and five multi-state award recipients, according to the EPA.

What is a solar for all grant?

Reaching communities in all states and territories, including in Tribal Lands, maximizing the reach and breadth of Solar for All. Collectively, the 60 Solar for All grant recipients will implement programs that cover all 50 states, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, and several territories.

What information does solar for all provide?

It also provides maps of the states covered by multistate grantees , and information that is useful to Solar for All grantees such as examples of position descriptions or requests for proposals for programmatic functions necessary to deploy low-income solar programs.

How does solar for all work?

100% of Solar for All funding will support the low-income and disadvantaged



communities that need it most, ensuring that the program benefits flow to the most overburdened communities. The average low-income household benefiting from a Solar for All program will experience ~\$400 in annual savings from their electricity bills.

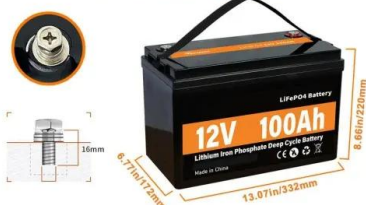
