Overview

What are China's 24 solar terms?

China's 24 solar terms is a knowledge system and social practice formed through observations of the sun's annual motion, and cognition of the year's changes in season, climate and phenology. Ancient Chinese divided the Sun's movement through the sky into 24 segments, with each segment equaling one roughly two-week-long "solar term".

How many solar terms are there in China?

Uncover fascinating histories and witness New China. The 24 Chinese solar terms refer to seasonal weather, wildlife, and farming activity. There are two per month or zodiac sign in the traditional solar calendar.

What does the name of a solar term mean?

The name of each solar term also refers to the period of time between that day and the next solar term, or 1/24th of a year. ^ "24 Chinese Feasts (Jiéqì, \square), equivalent to the 24 Chinese Solar Terms".

Why did ancient China use the 24 solar terms?

In ancient Chinese culture, the rhythms of nature synchronised seamlessly with the agricultural cycle. Among the tools used for agricultural planning and development in ancient China, the 24 Solar Terms (☐☐☐☐☐) played a crucial role.

What are some Chinese rituals based on solar terms?

Some rituals and festivities in China are closely associated with the Solar Terms for example, the First Frost Festival of the Zhuang People and the Ritual for the Beginning of Spring in Jiuhua. The terms may also be referenced in nursery rhymes, ballads and proverbs.

How many solar terms are there?



Solar Terms are divided according to the sun's annual motion in the ecliptic plane (the Earth's orbit around the Sun). It is part of the traditional Chinese calendar zodiac. The 24 Solar Terms were inscribed on the Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity by UNESCO in 2016. Beginning of Spring in Southern China.


