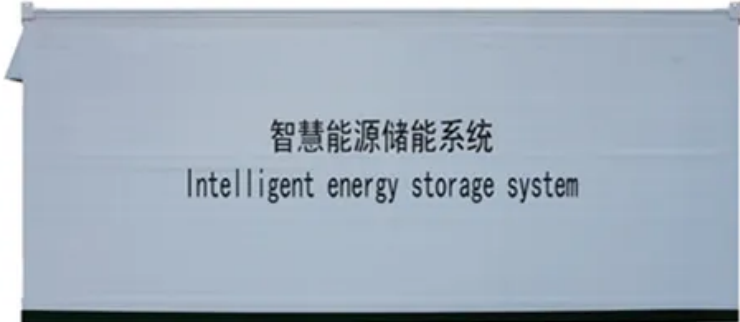

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Overview

The remaining objects of the Solar System (including the four terrestrial planets, the dwarf planets, moons, asteroids, and comets) together comprise less than 0.002% of the Solar System's total mass.

The Solar System consists of the Sun and the objects that orbit it. The name comes from Sōl, the Latin name for the sun. It was when a dense region of a collapsed molecular cloud, creating the Sun.

PastThe Solar System formed at least 4.568 billion years ago from the gravitational collapse of a region within a large molecular cloud. This initial cloud was likely several light-years across and probably birthed several stars.

The Sun is the Solar System's star and by far its most massive component. Its large mass (332,900 Earth masses), which comprises 99.86% of all the mass in the Solar System.

The outer region of the Solar System is home to the gas giants and their large moons. The Kuiper belt and many other objects orbit in this region.

The Solar System includes the Sun and all objects that are bound to it by gravity and orbit it. The heliocentric model describes the Solar System.

The inner Solar System is the region comprising the terrestrial planets and the asteroid belt. Composed mainly of silicates and metals, the objects of the inner Solar System are rocky.

What are minor bodies in the Solar System?

Minor bodies in the Solar System include all objects that are neither planets, dwarf planets, nor moons. These include: Asteroids – Also called "small planets," they primarily reside in the Asteroid Belt between Mars and Jupiter. Meteoroids – Smaller fragments of asteroids or comets that can enter Earth's atmosphere as meteors.

What is a small body in the Solar System?

Any natural solar system object other than the Sun, a planet, a dwarf planet, or a moon is called a small body; these include asteroids, meteoroids, and comets. Most of the more than one million asteroids, or minor planets, orbit between Mars and Jupiter in a nearly flat ring called the asteroid belt.
