Instead of turning sunlight directly into electricity, concentrating solar turns it into heat.

How is solar power generated?

Solar power is generated in two main ways: Solar photovoltaic (PV) uses electronic devices, also called solar cells, to convert sunlight directly into electricity. It is one of the fastest-growing renewable energy technologies and is playing an increasingly important role in the global energy transformation.

What is solar thermal energy?

Solar thermal energy is a way of using sunlight to generate heat instead of electricity. It works by capturing the sun's rays and converting them into thermal (heat) energy, which can then be used for heating water, warming spaces, or even producing electricity depending on the temperature level and the technology used.

Why is solar energy classified as renewable?

Solar energy is classified as renewable because it is derived from the sun, which, for all practical purposes on Earth, is an inexhaustible source of energy. The sun has been producing energy for about 5 billion years through nuclear fusion reactions in its core, and it is expected to continue doing so for several billion more years.
