What objects are in the Solar System?

Solar system objects include planets, dwarf planets, moons, asteroids, comets, and Kuiper belt objects. Our solar system is located in the Milky Way galaxy's Orion Arm, a minor spiral arm. The solar system resides 27,000 light-years from the galactic center on the inner rim. The Orion Arm is situated between the Sagittarius Arm and the Perseus Arm.

What types of planets are in the Solar System?

Solar system planets are divided into two main categories: terrestrial planets and gas giants. The four inner terrestrial planets (Mercury, Venus, Earth, Mars) have rocky compositions. The four outer gas giant planets (Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, Neptune) have gaseous compositions.
